Twelve Steps Sermon Series Continues

The *Christian Twelve Steps* are a practical, time-tested approach for applying the truth of God's Word to our daily lives.

1. We admitted we were powerless over one or more of our personal problems- that our lives had become unmanageable. (Romans 7:18)
2. We came to believe that a power greater than ourselves, Jesus Christ, could restore us to sanity.(Proverbs 3:5-6)
3. We made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God. (II Chronicles 16:9)
4. We made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves. (Lamentations 3:40)
5. We admitted to God, ourselves, and another person the exact nature of our wrongs. (James 5:16)
6. **We were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character. (Psalm 51:10)**
7. **We humbly asked God to remove our shortcomings. (I John 1:9)**
8. We made a list of all persons we had harmed and became willing to make amends to them all. (Luke 6:31)
9. We made direct amends to such people whenever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others. (Matthew 5:23-24)
10. We continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong, we promptly admitted it. (I Corinthians 10:12)
11. We sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God, praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry it out. (Proverbs 2:3-5)
12. Having had a spiritual awakening as a result of these steps, we try to carry God's message to all those in need and to practice these principles in all our affairs. (Galatians 6:1)

California Fire Relief

Lutheran Disaster Response, a collaborative ministry of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and the Lutheran Church -Missouri Synod, is responding to the people and the devastation left by the fires in California.

Several of the local Lutheran churches are providing assistance by providing shelter, distributing food and other supplies. Wildfires impacted 7 of the 10 counties in Southern California. The fires spread from Santa Barbara, California to the border of California and Mexico.

If you would like to help financially, you may give through Cross of Glory, by writing a check to ELCA Disaster Response. You can donate by mailing a check made out to ELCA Disaster Response, P.O. Box 71764, Chicago, IL 60694-1764 and designate your giving to "Southern California Wildfires" using the check's memo line. You can also donate using a major credit card by calling 800-638-3522 and designating your donation to "Southern California Wildfires".

Your prayers and gifts are needed and welcomed. When designating your gift for a specific disaster, 100 percent of that gift is used for immediate relief and long-term recovery efforts following that disaster. Should a response become fully funded, additional designated gifts will be applied to a similar domestic or international response.
